



# Free Services Offered at Evergreen

For other health-related services, contact Health Department (732 855-0600)

State agencies and local businesses come to Evergreen at scheduled intervals to provide valuable information and services for seniors.

**Health and Wellness** – The *Woodbridge Medical Group* conducted a <u>free wellness day</u> on June 17, offering services covered by Medicare *without co-pay and no deductible*. The tests the group performed included bone

density ultrasound scans for osteoporosis; peripheral artery disease and nerve tests; abdominal aorta ultra- sound scans for aneurysms; and carotid ultrasound. *Walgreen* staff provided very helpful diet supplement information.

**Blood Pressure Check** – *Department of Health* nurses come to Evergreen second Monday of the month to check blood pressure.

**Car Care Services** – Every last Tuesday of the month, *Jiffy Lube* comes to Evergreen to offer free automobile tire check and fluid top off.
